

BUCK'S MILL

In 1751 John Michie patented 400 acres next to his own and Capt. Merriweather's on Harris Creek.

A James Michie made a Will here - 1778 - he had a son James, who got land from him. This Will was in Will Book 2, page 318. He was a son of John.

In 1801, James Michie married Henrietta Ragland. He died before she did. He left her his large estate on Harris Creek. (I do not know the date of his Will.)

She died prior to 1849, and her Will named Executors, and they made a deed July 11, 1849 to John S. Buck for tract of land, 446 acres on Harris Creek, with Mill. Deed Book "BB", Page 88, Louisa.

Ever since, this has been known as "Buck's Mill" on old Price's Road, now number 208.
